20	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
22	Article - Commercial Law

24	(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

- 1 (b) "Controlled outlet" means an outlet which is operated by a distributor or operated by company employees, a subsidiary company, commissioned agent, or by any person who manages the outlet on a fee arrangement with the distributor.
  - (e) (1) "Distributor" means a person who:
- 5 (i) Engages in the sale, consignment, or distribution of gasohol or gasoline products through retail outlets which [he] THE PERSON owns or leases; and
- 8 (ii) Maintains an oral or written contractual relationship with a 9 dealer for the sale of the products.
- 10 (2) "Distributor" includes any subsidiary or affiliated corporation in which a distributor holds at least 30 percent voting control.
- 12 (h) "Independent jobber" means [an individual or corporation] A PERSON 13 who [purchases]:
- 14 **(1) PURCHASES** gasohol or gasoline products from a wholesaler for 15 resale to a dealer; **AND**
- 16 (2) DOES NOT OWN, LEASE, OPERATE, OR CONTROL, DIRECTLY OR THROUGH AN AFFILIATE, RETAIL OUTLETS.

- A distributor who sets the retail price of gasoline through 19 (1)(1) 20 controlled outlets shall provide those noncontrolled outlets [that it supplies with] TO 21 WHICH THE DISTRIBUTOR SELLS THE SAME GRADE, BRAND, AND QUALITY OF 22 GASOLINE IN THE SAME COMPETITIVE AREA AS THE CONTROLLED OUTLETS 23 gasoline products at a wholesale price of at least 4 cents per gallon under the lowest 24RETAIL price posted for each grade of gasoline at any controlled outlet IN THE SAME 25 COMPETITIVE AREA.
- 26 **(2)** Violation of this subsection constitutes price discrimination as 27 prohibited by § 11–204(a)(3) of this title.
- [(2)] (3) The provisions of this [act] SUBSECTION do not apply to independent jobbers and farm cooperatives.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2010.
