A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Business Regulation - Returnable Containers - Plastic Secondary Packaging

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from accepting possession of more 4 than a certain number of items of plastic secondary packaging for a certain 5 purpose; requiring certain persons that purchase certain plastic secondary 6 packaging to make a certain record of each transaction in which a person sells a 7 certain number of items of plastic secondary packaging; requiring certain 8 purchasers to verify the identity of certain sellers in a certain manner; requiring 9 certain purchasers to keep certain records of certain transactions; requiring 10 certain records to be kept for a certain period of time; providing that a person that violates this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a certain fine; 11 12 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the possession and purchase of plastic secondary packaging. 13

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING" MEANS
- 24 A PLASTIC CRATE OR SHELL USED FOR THE BULK TRANSPORTATION, STORAGE,

25 OR CARRYING OF RETAIL ITEMS.

- 3 SECONDARY PACKAGING.
- 4 (B) OTHER THAN A MANUFACTURER OF PLASTIC SECONDARY 5 PACKAGING, A PERSON MAY NOT ACCEPT POSSESSION OF FOUR OR MORE ITEMS
- 6 OF PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECYCLING,
- 7 SHREDDING, OR DESTROYING THE ITEMS.
- 8 (C) (1) EACH PERSON THAT PURCHASES AN ITEM OF PLASTIC
- 9 SECONDARY PACKAGING, INCLUDING A PERSON THAT IS IN THE BUSINESS OF
- 10 RECYCLING, SHREDDING, OR DESTROYING PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING,
- 11 SHALL MAKE A WRITTEN RECORD OF EACH TRANSACTION IN WHICH A PERSON
- 12 SELLS FOUR OR MORE ITEMS OF PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING, THAT SHOWS
- 13 THAT THE PERSON SELLING THE PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING HAS LAWFUL
- 14 POSSESSION OR OWNERSHIP OF THE PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING.
- 15 (2) FOR EACH TRANSACTION SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (1) OF
- 16 THIS SUBSECTION, THE PURCHASER SHALL:
- 17 (I) VERIFY THE SELLER'S IDENTITY BY A DRIVER'S LICENSE
- 18 OR OTHER GOVERNMENT-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION; AND
- 19 (II) MAKE A RECORD OF EACH TRANSACTION THAT
- 20 INCLUDES:
- 1. THE NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, AND
- 22 SIGNATURE OF THE SELLER OR THE SELLER'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE;
- 23 2. THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE BUYER;
- 3. THE REGISTRATION NUMBER AND LICENSE TAG
- 25 NUMBER OF ANY VEHICLE USED IN THE DELIVERY OF THE PLASTIC SECONDARY
- 26 PACKAGING;
- 4. A DESCRIPTION OF THE ITEMS SOLD, INCLUDING
- 28 THE NUMBER OF UNITS; AND
- 29 5. THE DATE OF THE TRANSACTION.
- 30 (D) THE PURCHASER SHALL KEEP THE RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS
- 31 SECTION FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF PURCHASE.

- 1 (E) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 2 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$100.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2010.
