- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from accepting possession of 4 purchasing more than a certain number of items of plastic secondary packaging $\mathbf{5}$ for a certain purpose; requiring certain persons that purchase certain plastic 6 secondary packaging to make a certain record of each transaction in which a 7person sells a certain number of items of plastic secondary packaging; requiring 8 certain purchasers to verify the identity of certain sellers in a certain manner; 9 requiring certain purchasers to keep certain records of certain transactions; 10 requiring certain records to be kept for a certain period of time; providing that a person that violates this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a certain 11 fine; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the possession and 12purchase of plastic secondary packaging. 13

2 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING" MEANS 3 A PLASTIC CRATE OR SHELL USED FOR THE BULK TRANSPORTATION, STORAGE, 4 OR CARRYING OF RETAIL ITEMS.

5 (2) "PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING" INCLUDES MILK CRATES, 6 BAKERY AND SOFT DRINK TRAYS, AND OTHER COMMERCIAL PLASTIC 7 SECONDARY PACKAGING.

8 **(B) O**THER THAN A MANUFACTURER OF PLASTIC SECONDARY 9 PACKAGING, A PERSON MAY NOT ACCEPT POSSESSION OF <u>PURCHASE</u> FOUR OR 10 MORE ITEMS OF PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING FOR THE PURPOSE OF 11 RECYCLING, SHREDDING, OR DESTROYING THE ITEMS.

12EACH PERSON THAT PURCHASES AN ITEM OF PLASTIC (C) (1) 13SECONDARY PACKAGING, INCLUDING A PERSON THAT IS IN THE BUSINESS OF 14RECYCLING, SHREDDING, OR DESTROYING PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING, SHALL MAKE A WRITTEN RECORD OF EACH TRANSACTION IN WHICH A PERSON 1516 SELLS FOUR OR MORE ITEMS OF PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING, THAT SHOWS 17THAT THE PERSON SELLING THE PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING HAS LAWFUL 18 POSSESSION OR OWNERSHIP OF THE PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING.

19 (2) FOR EACH TRANSACTION SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (1) OF 20 THIS SUBSECTION, THE PURCHASER SHALL:

21(I)VERIFY THE SELLER'S IDENTITY BY A DRIVER'S LICENSE22OR OTHER GOVERNMENT-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION; AND

 5. THE DATE OF THE TRANSACTION.
 (D) THE PURCHASER SHALL KEEP THE RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF PURCHASE.
 (E) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$100.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2010.
