14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19	in the waters of the State from which catching oysters or clams is permitted under the

- 3 (2) [This] EXCEPT AS SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, 4 THIS section does not affect any provision of this subtitle concerning the licensing or 5 regulation of catching oysters or clams [, except as specifically provided in this section].
 - (B) ANY RESIDENT OF THE STATE MAY CATCH OYSTERS OR CLAMS ON ANY AREA IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE FROM WHICH CATCHING OYSTERS OR CLAMS IS PERMITTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 9 (C) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING § 4–215(H) OF THIS TITLE, THE 10 DEPARTMENT MAY NOT PROHIBIT THE USE OF PATENT TONGS OR POWER 11 DREDGES TO CATCH OYSTERS IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE.
- 12 (2) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF THE
 13 DEPARTMENT TO REGULATE THE TIME AND MANNER OF THE USE OF PATENT
 14 TONGS AND POWER DREDGES TO CATCH OYSTERS IN THE WATERS OF THE
 15 STATE.
