FOR the purpose of requiring that a certain registration plates for a vehicle display the words "Home of Our National Anthem"; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to requirements for registration plates.

Section 13-410(b) Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2009 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

13-410.
(b) (1) Each registration plate shall display:
(i) The registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued; [and]

(3) PARAGRAPH (1)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER § 13-618, § 13-619, OR § 13-619.1, OR § 13-619.2 OF THIS TITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to registration plates manufactured on or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
