AN ACT concerning
Dorchester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Restaurant Seating Reqiment Capacity

FOR the purpose of altering in Dorchester County the minimum seating capacity required for certain restaurants and restaurant facilities to obtain a beer, wine, and liquor license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Dorchester County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

6-201.
(k) (1) This subsection applies only in Dorchester County.
(2) (i) $\ddagger$ Bona fide restaurants, motels and hotels having restaurant facilities for serving full-course meals at least twice daily and seating capacity at tables for $\mathbf{5 0}$ or more persons, not including seats at bars or counters, may obtain a license from the Board of License Commissioners.
