4 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination provision applicable to the Maryland
5 Military Installation Council; removing certain limits on the terms of certain
6 Council members; adding certain members to the Council; altering the
7 membership of the Council; providing for the terms of certain appointed
8 members; removing the requirement for the issuance of a final report by the
9 Council; repealing certain contingent provisions; and generally relating to the
10 Maryland Military Installation Council.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Economic Development**

15 11–203.

16 (a) The Council consists of the following members:

17 (1) three members selected by the President of the Senate of Maryland
18 to represent community interests, of which:

19 (i) one shall be a member of the Senate; and

20 (ii) two shall be citizens representing communities adjacent to
21 military installations;

22 (2) three members selected by the Speaker of the House of Delegates
23 to represent community interests, of which:

24 (i) one shall be a member of the House of Delegates; and

25 (ii) two shall be citizens representing communities adjacent to
26 military installations;

27 (3) the Secretary, or the designee of the Secretary;

28 (4) the Secretary of Transportation, or the designee of the Secretary of
29 Transportation;

30 (5) the Secretary of the Environment, or the designee of the Secretary
31 of the Environment;

1 (6) the Secretary of Planning, or the designee of the Secretary of
2 Planning;

3 (7) **THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, OR THE DESIGNEE**
4 **OF THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS;**

5 (8) **THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THE MARYLAND NATIONAL**
6 **GUARD, OR THE DESIGNEE OF THE ADJUTANT GENERAL;**

7 [(7)] (9) the President of the Southern Maryland Navy Alliance;

8 [(8)] (10) the President of the Army Alliance;

9 [(9)] (11) the President of the ~~Naval Energetics Alliance~~ **INDIAN**
10 **HEAD DEFENSE ALLIANCE;**

11 [(10)] (12) the President of the Maritime Alliance;

12 [(11)] (13) the President of the Fort Detrick Alliance;

13 [(12)] (14) the President of the Fort Meade Alliance;

14 [(13)] (15) the President of the Andrews Business and Community
15 Alliance; and

16 [(14)] (16) five members selected by the Governor.

17 (b) (1) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
18 Delegates shall each appoint three [new] members representing community interests
19 to serve as members of the Council [from July 1, 2009, to December 31, 2011].

20 (2) The chair may appoint:

21 (i) additional members who are presidents of other military
22 base advocacy groups that are not-for-profit organizations and recognized by the
23 Department; and

24 (ii) ex officio members as necessary to address specific issues,
25 including a representative of the Maryland National Guard.

26 [(c) Except as provided in subsection (b)(1) of this section, the term of a
27 member of the Council appointed by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the
28 House of Delegates expires on June 30, 2009.]

29 (c) (1) **THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.**
