BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article – Transportation** 17 18 13–602.

- 1 (a) (1) Subject to the provisions of this part, a licensed dealer may issue one temporary registration plate for a vehicle to the person who buys the vehicle from the dealer, whether or not the vehicle is to be registered in this State.
- 4 (2) The dealer may not issue more than one temporary registration for 5 any vehicle.
- 6 (b) Before a temporary registration plate may be issued for a vehicle, the 7 buyer of the vehicle shall complete and deliver to the dealer a temporary registration 8 plate application, on the form that the Administration requires.
- 9 (c) On the same day that a dealer issues a temporary registration plate for a vehicle, the dealer shall [send]:
- 11 **(1) SEND** to the Administration a copy of the temporary registration plate application completed by the buyer of the vehicle; **AND**
- 13 (2) ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMIT TO THE ADMINISTRATION, IN 14 THE FORMAT THAT THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES, THE VEHICLE, OWNER, 15 INSURANCE, AND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION INFORMATION CONTAINED ON 16 THE TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATE APPLICATION.

- 18 (a) Each dealer who has applied for temporary registration plates under § 13–601 of this subtitle shall keep a [permanent] record **FOR 3 YEARS** of all temporary registration plates delivered to the dealer.
- 21 (b) Each dealer who has applied for temporary registration plates under § 22 13–601 of this subtitle shall keep a [permanent] record **FOR 3 YEARS** of all temporary 23 registration plates issued by the dealer.
- 24 (c) Each dealer who has applied for temporary registration plates under § 25 13–601 of this subtitle shall keep a [permanent] record FOR 3 YEARS of any other 26 relevant information that the Administration requires.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
