- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 - 17 (a) In lieu of or in addition to suspension of the license, the Board may
 18 impose a penalty of not more than [\$5,000] \$10,000.
 - 19 (b) In addition to revocation of the license, the Board may impose a penalty 20 of not more than [\$5,000] **\$10,000**.
 - (c) Penalties collected by the Board under this section shall be paid into theGeneral Fund of the State.
