- FOR the purpose of clarifying the authority of the Department of Agriculture to charge
 a fee for the retaking of certain examinations; requiring the operator of a pest
 control business annually to register certain employees with the Department;
 establishing certain registration and renewal fees; requiring the payment of
 certain late fees for certain applicants for a certain license, certificate, or
 registration renewal; and generally relating to requirements for the application
 of pesticide.

1 Each applicant for a pest control consultant certificate, pest control (c) $\mathbf{2}$ applicator certificate, or public agency applicator certificate shall demonstrate 3 competence to consult on pest control or to apply pesticides safely in the State by passing a written examination prepared and administered by the Department. There 4 $\mathbf{5}$ shall be no charge for an initial examination, provided that each pest control 6 applicator or each pest control consultant shall pay \$10 for each [category of] 7examination **RETAKEN** after the initial examination. Each applicant for a private 8 applicator certificate shall pass an examination given by the Department. A private 9 applicator certificate is valid for 3 years and may be renewed by the certificate holder 10 by participation in training approved by the Department.

11 (J) (1) ANY PERSON WHO OPERATES A PEST CONTROL BUSINESS 12 SHALL REGISTER ANNUALLY WITH THE DEPARTMENT EACH EMPLOYEE, OTHER 13 THAN A CERTIFIED APPLICATOR, WHO OFFERS OR PERFORMS PEST CONTROL AT 14 EACH BUSINESS LOCATION.

15(2)THE APPLICATION FEE TO REGISTER AN EMPLOYEE INITIALLY16IS \$30.

17(3) THE ANNUAL RENEWAL FEE TO REGISTER AN EMPLOYEE IS18\$30.

19 (K) IF AN APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE, CERTIFICATE, OR 20 REGISTRATION IS RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT MORE THAN 10 DAYS AFTER 21 THE EXPIRATION OF THE LICENSE, CERTIFICATE, OR REGISTRATION, THE 22 APPLICANT IS SUBJECT TO A \$30 LATE FEE.
