1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (c) Each applicant for a pest control consultant certificate, pest control applicator certificate, or public agency applicator certificate shall demonstrate competence to consult on pest control or to apply pesticides safely in the State by passing a written examination prepared and administered by the Department. There shall be no charge for an initial examination, provided that each pest control applicator or each pest control consultant shall pay \$10 for each [category of] examination RETAKEN after the initial examination. Each applicant for a private applicator certificate shall pass an examination given by the Department. A private applicator certificate is valid for 3 years and may be renewed by the certificate holder by participation in training approved by the Department.
- 15 (J) (1) ANY PERSON WHO OPERATES A PEST CONTROL BUSINESS 16 SHALL REGISTER ANNUALLY WITH THE DEPARTMENT EACH EMPLOYEE, OTHER 17 THAN A CERTIFIED APPLICATOR, WHO OFFERS OR PERFORMS PEST CONTROL AT 18 EACH BUSINESS LOCATION.
- 19 **(2)** The application fee to register an employee initially 20 is \$30.
- 21 (3) THE ANNUAL RENEWAL FEE TO REGISTER AN EMPLOYEE IS 22 \$30.
- 23 (K) If AN APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE, CERTIFICATE, OR
 24 REGISTRATION IS RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT MORE THAN 40 30 DAYS
 25 AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF THE LICENSE, CERTIFICATE, OR REGISTRATION,
 26 THE APPLICANT IS SUBJECT TO A \$30 LATE FEE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
