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## **Public Defender Board of Trustees - Composition**

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the composition of the Board of Trustees of the Office of the Public Defender; altering the manner by which members of the Board of 4 5 Trustees are appointed; establishing qualifications of members of the Board of 6 Trustees; establishing the number of members of the Board of Trustees 7 necessary for a quorum; authorizing a certain number of members of the Board 8 of Trustees to call for additional meetings; providing for diversity of 9 membership of the Board of Trustees; providing for the manner in which vacancies are filled on the Board of Trustees; and generally relating to the 10 Board of Trustees of the Office of the Public Defender. 11

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 21 (a) There is a Board of Trustees of the Office of the Public Defender.
- 22 (b) The Board of Trustees consists of [three] THE FOLLOWING ELEVEN 23 [members appointed by the Governor.] MEMBERS:
  - (1) FOUR MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

$\frac{1}{2}$	(2) TWO MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS;
4	COURT OF THE LEALS,
3 4	(3) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
5	(4) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;
6 7	(5) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE BAR ASSOCIATION;
8 9	(6) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE DEAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF LAW; AND
10 11	(7) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE DEAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE SCHOOL OF LAW.
12 13	(c) (1) Each member of the Board of Trustees shall be a resident of the State.
14 15	(2) [Two] AT LEAST NINE members of the Board of Trustees shall be active attorneys admitted to practice before the Court of Appeals of Maryland.
16 17	(D) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, IN APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE BOARD, THE APPOINTING AUTHORITIES SHALL ENSURE THAT:
18 19	(1) EACH GEOGRAPHIC REGION OF THE STATE IS REPRESENTED EQUITABLY; AND
20 21	(2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES COLLECTIVELY REFLECTS THE RACIAL, ETHNIC, AGE, AND GENDER DIVERSITY OF THE STATE.
22	[(d)] (E) (1) The term of a member of the Board of Trustees is 3 years.
23 24 25	(2) A vacancy occurring on the Board of Trustees during the term of a member shall be filled [by the Governor] for the remainder of the unexpired term IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED FOR APPOINTMENTS IN THIS SECTION.
26 27	[(e)] (F) (1) The Board of Trustees annually shall elect a chair from among its members.

28 (2) The chair shall preside over and represent the interests of the 29 Board of Trustees in carrying out this title.
