3 FOR the purpose of altering the composition of the Board of Trustees of the Office of 4 the Public Defender: altering the manner by which members of the Board of $\mathbf{5}$ Trustees are appointed; establishing qualifications of members of the Board of 6 Trustees: establishing the number of members of the Board of Trustees 7necessary for a quorum; authorizing a certain number of members of the Board 8 of Trustees to call for additional meetings; providing for diversity of 9 membership of the Board of Trustees: providing for the manner in which 10 vacancies are filled on the Board of Trustees repealing the requirement that the Public Defender serve at the pleasure of the Board of Trustees of the Office of 11 12the Public Defender: specifying that the Board of Trustees may remove the 13Public Defender for certain reasons, only on the recommendation of the Board of 14Trustees; providing that the Public Defender may serve for a certain term; increasing the number of members of the Board of Trustees; altering the 15method of selection of the members of the Board of Trustees; increasing the 1617 number of members of the Board of Trustees who are required to be active 18 attorneys admitted to practice before the Court of Appeals of Maryland; requiring certain members of the Board of Trustees to have certain 1920qualifications; prohibiting certain persons from serving on the Board of Trustees; providing for the staggering of terms of the Board of Trustees; 2122specifying that at the end of a term a member of the Board of Trustees 23continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies; authorizing the reappointment to the Board of Trustees of a member whose term has expired; 2425providing for the manner of appointing a member to fill a vacancy on the Board
