1 AN ACT concerning

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## **International Marriage Brokers - Regulation**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring an international marriage broker to provide certain 4 information to a recruit; requiring a client of an international marriage broker 5 to provide certain information to the international marriage broker and to 6 affirm that certain information is accurate and complete; requiring an 7 international marriage broker to request certain criminal history records checks 8 from the Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository; requiring the Central Repository to process certain State and national criminal history 9 10 records checks on submission of certain information and fees; prohibiting an international marriage broker from providing services to a certain client or 11 12 recruit until certain information is received and provided to a recruit; 13 prohibiting an international marriage broker from further dissemination of 14 certain information; providing that a certain international marriage broker 15 shall be deemed to be doing business in the State; establishing penalties for 16 violating this Act; requiring the court to consider certain factors in determining 17 a certain penalty; defining certain terms; and generally relating to international marriage brokers. 18
