## A BILL ENTITLED

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2 Anne Arundel County Public Schools – Office Discipline Referrals – Accountability Policy

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Anne Arundel County Board of Education to develop 5 a certain policy for accounting for certain office discipline referrals submitted in 6 certain schools on or before a certain date; requiring a certain policy to include 7 certain information; requiring the county board to implement a certain policy in 8 certain public schools in a certain school year; requiring the county board to 9 submit a certain report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; 10 defining a certain term; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to an accountability policy by the Anne Arundel County Board of 11 12 Education for office discipline referrals.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Education
- 21 **7–311.**
- 22 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL" MEANS A
  23 SCHOOL FORM THAT REFERS A STUDENT TO THE SCHOOL'S ADMINISTRATIVE

24 OFFICE TO ACT ON A DISCIPLINARY MATTER.

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- 1 (B) (1) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31, 2011, THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP A POLICY FOR ACCOUNTING FOR ALL OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRALS SUBMITTED IN SCHOOLS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD.
- 5 (2) THE ACCOUNTABILITY POLICY DEVELOPED UNDER 6 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:
- 7 (I) A SYSTEM FOR ASSIGNING EACH OFFICE DISCIPLINE 8 REFERRAL A UNIQUE NUMBER; AND
- 9 (II) A METHOD FOR PROVIDING A COPY OF THE NUMBERED 10 OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL TO THE INDIVIDUAL SUBMITTING THE OFFICE 11 DISCIPLINE REFERRAL AT THE TIME IT IS SUBMITTED.
- 12 (C) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL IMPLEMENT THE POLICY DEVELOPED 13 UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IN ALL SCHOOLS UNDER THE 14 JURISDICTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD IN THE 2011–2012 SCHOOL YEAR.
- ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2013, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL 15 (D) SUBMIT A REPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE 16 ARTICLE, TOTHE GENERAL ASSEMBLY 17 GOVERNMENT ON THE 18 IMPLEMENTATION AND STATUS OF THE OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL 19 ACCOUNTABILITY POLICY IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.
  - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2010. It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of June 30, 2014, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
