TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE IMPLEMENTATION AND STATUS OF THE OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL 2122 ACCOUNTABILITY POLICY IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY. 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 July 1, 2010. It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of June 30, 25 2014, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be 26 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
