2 **Advisory Committee on the Naming of State Facilities, Roads, and Bridges –**
3 **Repeal**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the Advisory Committee on the Naming of State
5 Facilities, Roads, and Bridges and other related provisions of law; and generally
6 relating to the naming of State facilities, roads, and bridges.

7 BY repealing

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Government**

15 **[2–10A–09.**

16 (a) In this section, “Committee” means the Advisory Committee on the
17 Naming of State Facilities, Roads, and Bridges established under this section.

18 (b) There is an Advisory Committee on the Naming of State Facilities, Roads,
19 and Bridges.

1 (c) The Committee consists of the following members:

2 (1) the Governor, or the Governor's designee;

3 (2) the President of the Senate, or the President's designee;

4 (3) the Speaker of the House of Delegates, or the Speaker's designee;

5 (4) the Comptroller, or the Comptroller's designee;

6 (5) the State Treasurer, or the Treasurer's designee;

7 (6) the Secretary of General Services, or the Secretary's designee;

8 (7) the Secretary of Transportation, or the Secretary's designee;

9 (8) the Director of the Maryland Historical Trust, or the Director's
10 designee; and

11 (9) a member of the public, appointed by the Governor.

12 (d) The Governor or the Governor's designee shall serve as chair of the
13 Committee.

14 (e) The Department of Legislative Services shall provide staff assistance to
15 the Committee.

16 (f) (1) The Committee shall consider and evaluate requests to name State
17 facilities, other than the facilities at a public institution of higher education, in honor
18 or memory of individuals.

19 (2) The Committee shall accept public testimony at hearings of the
20 Committee.

21 (g) (1) In accordance with § 2-1246 of this title, the Committee shall
22 submit an annual report to the General Assembly on or before January 1 of each year.

23 (2) The report shall include the recommendations of the Committee
24 with regard to any matter considered by the Committee under subsection (f) of this
25 section.]

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 2010.
