15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17Article - State Government189–1007.19(a)19(a)20(1)adopt regulations to:21(i)(i)govern the Archives;

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28October 1, 2010.
