1	AN ACT	concerning
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Business Regulation – Prepaid Mobile Phones and Prepaid Refill Cards – Retail Sales

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting sellers of prepaid mobile phones from selling more 5 than a certain number of prepaid mobile phones to a person within a certain 6 time period; requiring sellers to obtain and copy certain identification at a 7 certain time from the buyer of a prepaid mobile phone or prepaid refill card; 8 establishing record-keeping requirements for sellers; requiring sellers to submit 9 the records to certain entities at certain intervals; requiring entities that receive 10 the records to retain them for a certain period of time; providing that the 11 records are not public and are confidential; authorizing State and local law 12 enforcement officers to view the records during certain hours under certain 13 circumstances; providing that a buyer who presents false identification at the 14 time of purchase violates this Act; providing that each occurrence of certain 15 violations is a separate offense; establishing certain penalties; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the sale of prepaid mobile phones and prepaid 16 17 refill cards.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 11 (E) "PREPAID REFILL CARD" MEANS A CARD PURCHASED TO ADD

- 14 (F) "SELLER" MEANS A PERSON WHO SELLS PREPAID MOBILE PHONES

- 16 (G) "WIRELESS TELEPHONE SERVICE" MEANS A TRANSMISSION
- 17 SERVICE THAT ENABLES REAL-TIME TWO-WAY VOICE COMMUNICATION TO

- 20 A SELLER MAY NOT SELL MORE THAN THREE PREPAID MOBILE PHONES
- 21 TO A PERSON IN A SINGLE 24-HOUR PERIOD.

- 23 (A) (1) AT THE TIME OF SALE, A SELLER SHALL REQUIRE A BUYER TO
- 24 PRODUCE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION:
- 25 (I) A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE;
- 26 (II) A VALID MILITARY IDENTIFICATION CARD;
- 27 (III) A VALID PASSPORT; OR

- 1 (IV) ANY VALID GOVERNMENT-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION
- 2 CARD THAT CONTAINS THE NAME, BIRTH DATE, AND CURRENT ADDRESS OF THE

- 4 (2) THE SELLER SHALL MAKE A COPY OF THE IDENTIFICATION
- 5 PRODUCED BY THE BUYER UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND
- 6 RETAIN THE COPY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE.

- 8 (A) A SELLER SHALL MAKE A RECORD FOR EACH SALE OF A PREPAID
- 9 MOBILE PHONE OR PREPAID REFILL CARD AND RETAIN THE RECORD FOR AT
- 10 LEAST 2 YEARS.
- 11 (B) THE RECORD REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION
- 12 SHALL INCLUDE:
- 13 (1) THE NAME, BUSINESS ADDRESS, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF
- 14 THE SELLER;
- 15 (2) THE SERIAL NUMBER AND MANUFACTURER OF THE PREPAID
- 16 MOBILE PHONE;
- 17 (3) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE WIRELESS TELEPHONE
- 18 SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE PREPAID MOBILE PHONE OR PREPAID REFILL
- 19 **CARD**;
- 20 (4) A COPY OF THE IDENTIFICATION PRODUCED BY THE BUYER
- 21 UNDER § 19–602 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- 22 (5) THE DATE AND MANNER OF SUBMISSION OF THE RECORD AS
- 23 REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- 24 (C) (1) THE SELLER SHALL SUBMIT A COPY OF RECORDS MADE
- 25 UNDER THIS SECTION AT LEAST ONCE EACH MONTH TO:
- 26 (I) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE; AND
- 27 (II) THE WIRELESS TELEPHONE SERVICE PROVIDER FOR
- 28 THE PREPAID MOBILE PHONE OR PREPAID REFILL CARD.
- 29 (2) THE SUBMISSION IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION
- 30 MAY BE DONE ELECTRONICALLY IN A FORMAT THAT THE RECEIVING ENTITY
- 31 CAN SUCCESSFULLY RETRIEVE.

- 1 (3) THE RECEIVING ENTITY FOR RECORDS IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL RETAIN THE RECORDS FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR.
- 3 (D) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 4 SUBSECTION, A RECORD MADE UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD 5 AND SHALL BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL.
- 6 (2) RECORDS MADE AND KEPT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS
 7 SUBTITLE SHALL BE OPEN TO INSPECTION DURING BUSINESS HOURS BY STATE
 8 OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS FOR AN INVESTIGATION OF A
 9 SPECIFIC CRIME INVOLVING PREPAID MOBILE PHONES.

- 11 (A) A BUYER WHO PRESENTS FALSE IDENTIFICATION AT THE TIME OF 12 PURCHASE VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE.
- 13 (B) A SELLER MAY NOT FAIL TO MAKE, MAINTAIN, OR SUBMIT A RECORD 14 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE.
- 15 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A 16 MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE:
- 17 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, NOT EXCEEDING \$500; OR
- 18 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, NOT EXCEEDING 19 \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 30 DAYS OR BOTH.
- 20 (D) EACH TRANSACTION FOR WHICH A SELLER DOES NOT MAKE, 21 MAINTAIN, OR SUBMIT A RECORD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE AND 22 EACH OCCASION THAT A BUYER PRESENTS FALSE IDENTIFICATION AT THE TIME 23 OF PURCHASE IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
