3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a county to establish a seasonal farmer's market 4 producer sampling license to allow a producer of a farm product to prepare and $\mathbf{5}$ offer samples of the product at a farmer's market; requiring the license to be 6 valid at all farmer's markets in the county for a certain time period, for a single $\overline{7}$ fee; limiting a licensee to offer samples only of a product produced by the 8 licensee; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to adopt 9 certain regulations; requiring a county issuing the license to adopt certain ordinances; and generally relating to product sampling at farmer's markets. 10
