17 18 19 20 21	Every motor vehicle that is used by nursery schools, camps, day nurseries, or day care centers for children with an intellectual disability to transport children [and that is not regulated as a "school bus" under this article,] shall be equipped with seat belts for each seat and shall be subject to any other regulations adopted by the Administration, UNLESS THE MOTOR VEHICLE:
22	(1) IS A TYPE I SCHOOL VEHICLE; OR
23	(2) WAS FORMERLY REGISTERED AS A TYPE I SCHOOL VEHICLE.
