BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Business Regulation** 18–101.

5 6	(1) the landlord may not directly or indirectly require the merchant to open the merchant's place of business on Sunday; and
7 8 9	(2) a landlord may not directly or indirectly cancel or refuse to renew the merchant's lease because the merchant refuses to open the merchant's place of business on Sunday.
10 11 12 13	(d) Except in Howard, Montgomery, and Prince George's counties, and except as provided in subsection (g) of this section, a new or used car dealer may not sell, barter, deliver, give away, show, or offer for sale a motor vehicle or certificate of title for a motor vehicle on Sunday.
14 15 16	(e) In Anne Arundel County, a dealer may sell, barter, deliver, give away, show, or offer for sale on Sunday a new or used camping trailer, mobile home, or travel trailer, as those terms are defined in Title 11 of the Transportation Article.
17 18	(f) A new or used car dealer who violates subsection (d) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding \$10,000.
19 20 21	(g) In <b>ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY AND</b> Worcester County, a dealer may sell, barter, deliver, give away, show, or offer for sale a motorcycle, as defined in § 11–136 of the Transportation Article, or certificate of title for a motorcycle on Sunday.
22 23	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2010.
