3 FOR the purpose of adding a currently practicing nurse who has practiced acute care 4 nursing for at least a certain number of years to the State Board of Nursing;  $\mathbf{5}$ adding certain degrees that qualify an individual for the nurse administrator 6 member of the Board; requiring the registered nurse member of the Board who 7 is certified in advanced practice nursing to rotate among certain specialties; 8 authorizing certain professional nursing organizations to submit certain lists 9 from which the Governor can appoint certain Board members; authorizing certain licensed nurses to submit certain petitions from which the Governor can 10 appoint certain Board members; requiring that certain petitions have a certain 11 12number of signatures; requiring the Board to notify certain licensed nurses and 13 professional nursing organizations of certain vacancies on the Board; providing that members appointed to the Board reflect certain diversity of the State; 1415clarifying the term limitations for a member of the Board who is appointed after 16 a term has begun; and generally relating to membership and nominations for 17the State Board of Nursing.
