## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Health Insurance - Annual Preventive Care

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and 4 health maintenance organizations that provide covered benefits for annual 5 preventive care from denying coverage solely because a certain number of days 6 has not elapsed since the previous annual preventive care occurred; requiring 7 the insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance 8 organizations to provide coverage for the annual preventive care if certain 9 conditions are met; prohibiting certain provisions from being construed to 10 require coverage for a certain service; making certain requirements applicable 11 to health maintenance organizations; defining a certain term; and generally 12 relating to health insurance coverage for annual preventive care.

23	(1) MAY NOT DENY COVERAGE FOR THE ANNUAL PREVENTIVE
24	CARE SOLELY BECAUSE 365 DAYS HAVE NOT YET ELAPSED SINCE THE PREVIOUS
25	ANNUAL PREVENTIVE CARE OCCURRED; AND
26	(2) SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR THE ANNUAL PREVENTIVE
27	CARE IF:
28	(I) THE ANNUAL PREVENTIVE CARE IS PROVIDED NO MORE

THAN 45 DAYS BEFORE THE ANNIVERSARY DATE FOR THE ANNUAL PREVENTIVE

1	(II) ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS FOR COVERAGE OF THE
2	ANNUAL PREVENTIVE CARE ARE MET.
3	(D) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE COVERAGE
4	FOR A SERVICE NOT OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY LAW.
