3 FOR the purpose of providing that a certain person who receives a citation for a 4 certain offense related to unlawfully taking oysters may have a certain license 5 revoked under certain circumstances; establishing certain grounds for the 6 revocation of a certain license; requiring the Department of Natural Resources 7 to hold a certain hearing under certain circumstances in accordance with the 8 Administrative Procedure Act; requiring the Department to revoke a person's 9 license to catch oysters under certain circumstances; authorizing certain 10 aggrieved persons to obtain judicial review of a certain decision; prohibiting a certain person from using or receiving a certain license under certain 11 circumstances; and generally relating to unlawfully taking oysters and license 12 13 revocation.

- 23 (A) **(1)** IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY OR FINE PROVIDED IN 24THIS TITLE, A PERSON WHO HOLDS A LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS UNDER §

- 8 (I) TAKING OYSTERS FROM CLOSED OR PROHIBITED

- 11 (III) TAKING OYSTERS AT TIMES WHEN TAKING OYSTERS IS
- 12 **PROHIBITED**;
- 13 (IV) TAKING OYSTERS DURING CLOSED SEASONS; AND
- 14 (V) TAKING OYSTERS FROM A LEASED AREA BY A PERSON
- 15 OTHER THAN THE LEASEHOLDER.
- 16 (B) (1) WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER A PERSON WHO HOLDS A LICENSE TO
- 17 CATCH OYSTERS UNDER § 4-701 OF THIS TITLE RECEIVES A CITATION FOR AN
- 18 OFFENSE LISTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT
- 19 SHALL HOLD A HEARING ON THE MATTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
- 20 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE
- 21 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- 22 (2) AFTER A HEARING IS CONDUCTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF
- 23 THIS SUBSECTION, IF THE PRESIDING OFFICER FINDS OR CONCLUDES THAT THE
- 24 PERSON KNOWINGLY HAS COMMITTED AN OFFENSE LISTED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 25 (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVOKE THE PERSON'S
- 26 LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS.
- 27 (C) A PERSON WHO IS AGGRIEVED BY THE FINAL DECISION OF THE
- 28 DEPARTMENT MAY OBTAIN JUDICIAL REVIEW OF THE DECISION IN
- 29 ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT UNDER TITLE 10,
- 30 SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- 31 (D) A PERSON WHOSE LICENSE HAS BEEN REVOKED IN ACCORDANCE
- 32 WITH THIS SECTION MAY NOT USE A TIDAL FISH LICENSE ISSUED TO THE

- 1 PERSON TO CATCH OYSTERS OR RECEIVE A TRANSFER OF A TIDAL FISH LICENSE
- 2 TO CATCH OYSTERS AFTER REVOCATION.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 October 1, 2010.
