## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loans of 2007 and 2008 – Prince**  
3 **George’s County – Historic Laurel Mill Ruins**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loans of 2007  
5 and 2008 to alter the purpose of certain grants to the Mayor and City Council of  
6 the City of Laurel; extending the deadline by which the grantee must present  
7 evidence that a matching fund will be provided; and generally relating to  
8 certain grants for the Historic Laurel Mill Ruins and the Laurel Armory  
9 Anderson Murphy Community Center.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Chapter 488 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2007, as amended by  
12 Chapter 219 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2008

 29 **Mills Ruins] THE LAUREL ARMORY ANDERSON MURPHY**  
 30 **COMMUNITY CENTER, located in Laurel. Notwithstanding**  
 31 **Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real**

2 (BM) [Historic Laurel Mills Ruins] **LAUREL ARMORY ANDERSON**  
3 **MURPHY COMMUNITY CENTER.** Provide a grant equal to  
4 the lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching  
5 fund provided, to the Mayor and City Council of the City of  
6 Laurel for the [repair, stabilization; and] **RENOVATION,**  
7 reconstruction, **AND CAPITAL EQUIPPING** of [Historic Laurel  
8 Mills Ruins] **THE LAUREL ARMORY ANDERSON MURPHY**  
9 **COMMUNITY CENTER,** located in Laurel. Notwithstanding  
10 Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real  
11 property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the  
12 effective date of this Act **AND THE GRANTEE MUST PRESENT**  
13 **EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE PROVIDED**  
14 **BY JUNE 1, 2012** (Prince George’s County) ..... 100,000

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
16 June 1, 2010.
