- 4 (B) THE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION PROVIDED TO THE PATIENT UNDER 5 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MUST BE:
- 6 (1) SIGNED BY THE PATIENT AT THE TIME OF THE PATIENT'S 7 VISIT; AND
- 8 (2) RETAINED BY THE LICENSEE AS PART OF THE LICENSEE'S 9 PATIENT RECORDS.
- 10 (C) EACH LICENSEE PRACTICING MEDICINE IN THE STATE WHO DOES 11 NOT MAINTAIN PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE MUST 12 CONSPICUOUSLY POST SUCH INFORMATION IN THE LICENSEE'S PLACE OF 13 PRACTICE.
