- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 25 26 27	(III) SUPERVISION OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S PERFORMANCE OF TWO OR MORE ACTIVITIES OF DAILY LIVING COMBINED WITH THE NEED FOR SUPERVISION OF OR REDIRECTION FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO EXHIBITS AT LEAST TWO OF THE FOLLOWING BEHAVIORAL PROBLEMS:

SELF-INJURIOUS BEHAVIOR SEVERAL TIMES A 6 MONTH. 7 "INSTRUMENTAL ACTIVITIES OF DAILY LIVING" MEANS (4) 8 TELEPHONE USE, MONEY MANAGEMENT, HOUSEKEEPING, AND MEDICATION 9 MANAGEMENT. 10 **(B)** (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DETERMINE THAT AN INDIVIDUAL 11 IS MEDICALLY ELIGIBLE FOR NURSING FACILITY SERVICES OR FOR A NURSING 12FACILITY LEVEL OF CARE UNDER THE PROGRAM IF THE INDIVIDUAL REQUIRES, ON A REGULAR BASIS, HEALTH-RELATED SERVICES ABOVE THE LEVEL OF ROOM 1314AND BOARD.

15 (2) IF AN INDIVIDUAL DOES NOT DEMONSTRATE THE CLINICAL 16 NEED FOR HEALTH-RELATED SERVICES ABOVE THE LEVEL OF ROOM AND 17 BOARD ON A REGULAR BASIS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PERMIT THE 18 INDIVIDUAL TO SUBMIT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR CLINICAL REVIEW TO 19 DEMONSTRATE ELIGIBILITY UNDER APPLICABLE FEDERAL OR STATE 20 REGULATIONS.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 July 1, 2010.

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
