18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – State Personnel and Pensions

(g) (1) On or before December 31, 2008, the Commission shall issue an

State Government Article, the General Assembly.
