## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners - Licensure and Regulation 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners to send license renewal notices by electronic mail; altering the maximum amount 4 5 of a certain penalty; altering certain definitions; and generally relating to the 6 licensure and regulation of physical therapists and physical therapist 7 assistants. 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 9 Article – Health Occupations Section 13–101, 13–311, and 13–407 10 Annotated Code of Maryland 11 12 (2009 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 15 **Article – Health Occupations** 16 13-101. In this title the following words have the meanings indicated. 17 (a) (b) "Board" means the State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners. 18 19 "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued (c) 20 by the Board to practice: 21(1) Physical therapy; or 22(2)Limited physical therapy.

25 26	(j) "Restricted license" means a license issued by the Board under and as limited by § 13–314 of this title to practice physical therapy.

28	(a) A license expires on the date set by the Board, unless the license is			

renewed for an additional term as provided in this section. A license may not be

renewed for a term longer than 2 years.

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- 1 (b) At least 1 month before the license expires, the Board shall send to the 2 licensee, by first-class mail to the last known address of the licensee, OR BY 3 ELECTRONIC MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS OF THE 4 LICENSEE, a renewal notice that states: 5 (1) The date on which the current license expires: 6 The date by which the renewal application must be received by the (2)7 Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and 8 (3)The amount of the renewal fee. 9 Before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an 10 additional 2-year term, if the licensee: 11 (1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed; Pays to the Board a renewal fee set by the Board; and 12(2) Submits to the Board: 13 (3)14 (i) A renewal application on the form that the Board requires; 15 and 16 (ii) Satisfactory evidence of compliance with the other 17 qualifications set under this title for license renewal. 18 (d) The Board may adopt regulations to establish continuing education requirements as a condition for the renewal of licenses under this section. 19 20 (e) The Board shall renew the license of each licensee who meets the 21requirements of this section. 2213-407.23A person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a 24misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$5,000] \$10,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or both. 25
- 26 (b) (1) Any person who violates § 13–401 of this subtitle is subject to a civil fine of not more than \$50,000 to be assessed by the Board.
- 28 (2) The Board shall pay any penalty collected under this subsection 29 into the State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners Fund.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
