## 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- Article Transportation
  22-221.
  (l) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, a motorcycle may be equipped with, AND AN OPERATOR OF A MOTORCYCLE MAY USE, the following auxiliary lighting:
- 17 (i) Blue dot illumination;
- 18 (ii) Standard bulb running lights; or
