A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Correctional Services – Division of Parole and Probation – Supervision Fee

3 FOR the purpose of transferring certain responsibilities relating to the assessment of a certain supervision fee from the Parole Commission to the Division of Parole 4 $\mathbf{5}$ and Probation; repealing a requirement that the Division of Parole and 6 Probation investigate requests for a certain exemption under certain 7 circumstances; requiring the Division to conduct a certain examination of a 8 supervisee at certain times for certain purposes; defining a certain term; 9 making conforming changes; and generally relating to fees paid by individuals 10 supervised by the Division of Parole and Probation.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (a) (1) In this section[, "supervisee"] THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE 21 THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

22 (2) "DIVISION" MEANS THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND 23 PROBATION.
