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Higher Education – Sergey Brin Scholarship Program

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Sergey Brin Scholarship Program; authorizing 4 the Maryland Higher Education Commission to make scholarship awards to $\mathbf{5}$ certain recipients pursuing certain degrees; requiring a scholarship recipient to 6 meet certain eligibility criteria to obtain and retain an award; requiring the 7Commission to award applicants in a certain order of preference; requiring an 8 award not to exceed a certain amount per recipient; requiring a recipient to 9 meet certain criteria or else repay the State the amount of the scholarship award; requiring the Commission to update periodically the list of eligible 10 11 degrees; providing for the funding of the Program; authorizing the Commission 12to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to 13the establishment of the Sergey Brin Scholarship Program.

1 (III) IN THE JUDGMENT OF THE INSTITUTION, MAKE 2 SATISFACTORY PROGRESS TOWARD ONE OF THE DEGREES LISTED IN § 18–2902 3 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

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(IV) MAINTAIN THE STANDARDS OF THE INSTITUTION.

5 (3) IF THE COMMISSION REMOVES A DEGREE FROM THE LIST OF 6 ELIGIBLE DEGREES IN § 18–2902 OF THIS SUBTITLE, A CURRENT RECIPIENT 7 WHO HAS BEEN PURSUING THAT DEGREE FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR IS ELIGIBLE TO 8 CONTINUE HOLDING THE AWARD FOR THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED UNDER 9 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
