# Somerset, Wicomico, and Worcester Counties – Vehicle Laws – Exceptional Hauling Permits

4 FOR the purpose of including Somerset County, Wicomico County, and Worcester  $\mathbf{5}$ County as counties in which an exceptional hauling permit issued by the State 6 Highway Administration is valid for a combination of vehicles that transports  $\mathbf{7}$ certain forestry products, subject to certain axle configuration requirements, 8 increased maximum load limits, weight tolerances, inspection requirements, 9 operation restrictions and requirements, penalties, record keeping and reporting requirements, and fees; and generally relating to vehicle laws and 10 exceptional hauling permits. 11

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

  Allegany County [and Garrett County], GARRETT COUNTY, SOMERSET COUNTY,
