CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 State Retirement and Pension System – Eligible Governmental Units

3 FOR the purpose of providing that the effective date of certain eligible governmental 4 units to join the State Retirement and Pension System shall be postponed to a $\mathbf{5}$ certain date if the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension 6 System does not receive certain documents on or before a certain date from the $\overline{7}$ eligible governmental unit; making certain technical and clarifying changes to 8 the State Personnel and Pensions Article; deleting certain obsolete provisions in 9 the State Personnel and Pensions Article; defining certain terms; and generally relating to eligible governmental units participating in the State Retirement 10 11 and Pension System.
