- (a) (1) It is the intent of this section that each register shall receive a fair
- 23 and adequate compensation for the effort and duties required of the register by the

1 2 3	(2) The volume and character of work done by the register shall be in comparison to the salary fixed by the Board of Public Works for each of the other registers.
4 5	(b) (1) (I) Each register is entitled to receive an annual salary of not more than \$98,500, to be determined in each instance by the Board of Public Works.
6 7 8	(II) EACH REGISTER IS ENTITLED TO A COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT AWARDED IN THE SAME PERCENTAGE AND AT THE SAME TIME AS THAT AWARDED TO A STATE EMPLOYEE.
9 10	(2) In determining the annual salary of the register, the Board of Public Works shall be guided in the exercise of its discretion by:

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the registers of wills during a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of a register of wills shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
