## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning
Homeowner's, Farmowner's, and Dwelling Insurance Policies - Claims for Additional Payments

FOR the purpose of requiring each policy of homeowner's, farmowner's, or dwelling insurance issued, sold, or delivered in the State that provides certain coverage for a dwelling or personal property to contain a provision that allows an insured to file a claim for certain additional payments for at least a certain period of time; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to policies of homeowner's, farmowner's, and dwelling insurance.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 19-213.

EACH POLICY OF HOMEOWNER'S, FARMOWNER'S, OR DWELLING INSURANCE ISSUED, SOLD, OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE THAT PROVIDES PROPERTY COVERAGE FOR A DWELLING OR PERSONAL PROPERTY SHALL CONTAIN A PROVISION THAT ALLOWS AN INSURED TO FILE A CLAIM FOR ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS, ON A REPLACEMENT COST BASIS, FOR THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF THE DWELLING OR PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS AFTER PAYMENT OF ACTUAL CASH VALUE.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all homeowner's, farmowner's, and dwelling insurance policies issued, sold, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after October 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
