A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Election Law - Persons Doing Public Business - Independent Expenditures 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person doing public business from making an 4 independent expenditure for certain campaign material; defining a certain term; 5 altering a certain term relating to campaign contributions disclosure by persons 6 doing public business; and generally relating to independent expenditures on 7 campaign material by persons doing public business. 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 9 Article – Election Law Section 13–102 and 14–101(g) 10 Annotated Code of Maryland 11 12 (2003 Volume and 2009 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 15 Article - Election Law 16 13-102.17 Except for a candidate AND AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, this title does not prohibit an individual who acts independently of any 18 19 other person from: 20 (1) expressing personal views on any subject; or 21(2) making an expenditure of personal funds to purchase campaign 22 material.

- 1 (B) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "DOING PUBLIC BUSINESS" HAS THE 2 MEANING STATED IN § 14–101 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 3 (2) A PERSON DOING PUBLIC BUSINESS MAY NOT MAKE AN INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE FOR CAMPAIGN MATERIAL THAT SUPPORTS OR OPPOSES A CANDIDATE OR POLITICAL PARTY.

- 7 (g) (1) "Doing public business" means making, during any 12-month 8 period, one or more contracts with one or more governmental entities involving 9 cumulative consideration of at least [\$100,000] \$5,000.
- 10 (2) "Doing public business" does not include receiving a salary from a 11 governmental entity.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2010.
