- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) (1) THERE IS A MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION BUSINESS 19 COALITION.
- 20 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE COALITION IS TO PROMOTE
- 21 PARTNERSHIPS AND ENHANCE COOPERATION BETWEEN HIGHER EDUCATION
- 22 AND THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY IN THE STATE TO ACHIEVE THE STATE GOALS
- 23 FOR HIGHER EDUCATION EMBODIED IN THE STATE PLAN FOR POSTSECONDARY
- 24 EDUCATION.

- 4 (C) (1) THERE IS A MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION BUSINESS 5 COALITION FUND.
- 6 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO LEVERAGE PUBLIC,
 7 PRIVATE, AND FOUNDATION FUNDING TO PROMOTE THE STATE'S GOALS FOR
 8 HIGHER EDUCATION AND TO ENHANCE COOPERATION AND PARTNERSHIPS

- 10 (D) THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION BUSINESS COALITION SHALL 11 ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- 12 (E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT:
- 13 (I) IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE; AND
- 15 (II) MAY NOT BE USED AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR STATE 16 GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS.
- 17 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 19 **(F)** THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 20 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
- 21 (2) INVESTMENT EARNINGS FROM THE FUND; AND
- 22 (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED 23 FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 24 (G) THE FUND SHALL BE USED TO:
- 25 (1) PROMOTE PARTNERSHIPS AND ENHANCE COOPERATION 26 BETWEEN THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE AND THE
- 27 BUSINESS COMMUNITY;
- 28 (2) FACILITATE THE EXPANSION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW
- 29 PARTNERSHIP INITIATIVES;

- 10 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE 11 FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
- 12 (2) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE 13 CREDITED TO THE FUND.
- 14 (I) THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION BUSINESS COALITION FUND 15 IS SUBJECT TO AUDIT BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR AS PROVIDED UNDER § 16 2–1220 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
