17	(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
18	(2) "DISTRIBUTE" MEANS TO:

1 [(2)](3) "Tanning device" means any equipment that emits radiation 2 used for tanning of the skin, including sunlamps, tanning booths, or tanning beds.

3 **[**(3)**](4)** "Tanning facility" means any place where a tanning device is 4 used for a fee, membership dues, or other compensation.

(b) An owner, employee, or operator of a tanning facility may not:

6 (1) [allow] ALLOW a minor [under the age of 18 years] to use a 7 tanning device [unless the minor's parent or legal guardian provides written consent 8 on the premises of the tanning facility and in the presence of an owner, employee, or 9 operator of the tanning facility]; OR

10(2) DISTRIBUTE TO A MINOR A PASS, COUPON, OR PACKAGE11REDEEMABLE FOR USE OF A TANNING DEVICE.

12 (c) The owner, employee, or operator of a tanning facility shall require 13 appropriate documentation to verify the age of an individual before allowing the 14 individual access to a tanning device.

- 15 (d) (1) The Secretary may impose on a person who violates this section:
- 16 (i) For a first violation, a civil penalty not to exceed \$250;
- 17 (ii) For a second violation, a civil penalty not to exceed \$500; 18 and
- 19(iii)For each subsequent violation, a civil penalty not to exceed20\$1,000.
- 21 (2) The Secretary may adopt regulations to implement and carry out 22 this section.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 October 1, 2010.
