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Public Service Commission – Cost Reimbursement

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Public Service Commission to require a certain
applicant for authorization of certain transactions to reimburse the Commission
for certain costs; prohibiting a public service company from passing certain costs
on to ratepayers; requiring the Commission to provide certain notice to certain
applicants; providing that a reimbursement under this Act is not an assessment
under a certain provision of law and not subject to certain limitations; and
generally relating to reimbursable costs of the Public Service Commission.

3 (C) (1) AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE, ON RECEIVING AN APPLICATION 4 FOR AUTHORIZATION OF A TRANSACTION UNDER § 6–101 OR § 6–105 OF THIS 5 SUBTITLE, THE COMMISSION SHALL NOTIFY THE APPLICANT:

- 6 (I) THAT THE APPLICATION IS SUBJECT TO 7 REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION; AND
- 8 (II) OF THE ANTICIPATED EXPENSES THE COMMISSION 9 WILL INCUR THAT QUALIFY FOR REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION.

10 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH 11 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL NOTIFY AN APPLICANT OF 12 ANY CHANGES TO THE ANTICIPATED EXPENSES FOR WHICH THE COMMISSION 13 WILL SEEK REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION.

14(D)(1)PAYMENT FOR REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT15AN ASSESSMENT UNDER § 2–110 OF THIS ARTICLE.

16(2)THE LIMITATIONS UNDER § 2–110(C)(12) OF THIS ARTICLE DO17NOT APPLY TO A REIMBURSEMENT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 July 1, 2010.
