- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring a vehicle dealer who is required by law to make a 5 certain disclosure to consumers regarding the prior use of a vehicle to make a 6 reasonable inquiry about whether the vehicle formerly was used other than 7 primarily for personal, household, or family purposes; requiring a dealer to 8 disclose that the prior use of a vehicle is unknown under certain circumstances; 9 establishing that a dealer may comply with the requirements of this Act by providing the consumer with a certain vehicle history report; defining certain 10 terms; and generally relating to disclosures by vehicle dealers and unfair or 11 deceptive trade practices. 12

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 23 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 24 (2) "DEALER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 15–101 OF THE 25 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

- 1 (3) "VEHICLE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 11–176 OF THE 2 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.
- 3 (B) (1) If A DEALER IS REQUIRED BY LAW TO MAKE A DISCLOSURE TO
 4 A CONSUMER REGARDING THE PRIOR USE OF A VEHICLE, THE DEALER SHALL
 5 MAKE A REASONABLE INQUIRY ABOUT WHETHER THE VEHICLE FORMERLY WAS
 6 USED OTHER THAN PRIMARILY FOR PERSONAL, HOUSEHOLD, OR FAMILY
 7 PURPOSES.
- 8 (2) IF, AFTER AN INQUIRY UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
 9 SUBSECTION, THE NATURE OF THE PRIOR USE OF THE VEHICLE CANNOT BE
 10 DETERMINED, THE DEALER SHALL DISCLOSE TO THE CONSUMER THAT THE
 11 PRIOR USE OF THE VEHICLE IS UNKNOWN.
- 12 (C) A DEALER MAY COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
 13 SECTION BY PROVIDING A CONSUMER WITH A VEHICLE HISTORY REPORT
 14 PREPARED BY AN INDEPENDENT THIRD PARTY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
