- FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Natural Resources to provide certain information about certain proposed land purchases by the Department of Natural Resources to certain counties under certain circumstances; prohibiting the State from acquiring land for open space purposes in Dorchester County unless the County Council of Dorchester County approves the purchase; and generally relating to the acquisition of land by the Department of Natural Resources and the State in Dorchester County.
