Blue Ribbon Commission on Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force Blue Ribbon Commission on Alzheimer's 4 Disease and Related Disorders; providing for the membership of the Task Force 5 Blue Ribbon Commission; designating the chair of the Task Force Blue Ribbon 6 Commission; prohibiting a member of the Task Force Blue Ribbon Commission 7 from receiving compensation; authorizing a member of the Task Force Blue 8 Ribbon Commission to receive certain reimbursement; requiring 9 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to provide staff for the Task Force 10 Blue Ribbon Commission for certain purposes; requiring the Task Force Blue 11 Ribbon Commission to examine certain population data, survey certain 12 research, and assess existing services, resources, and capacity regarding 13 Alzheimer's disease and related disorders; requiring the Task Force Blue 14 Ribbon Commission to make certain recommendations; requiring the Task 15 Force Blue Ribbon Commission to make a certain report to the Governor and 16 General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of 17 this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force Blue Ribbon Commission on 18 Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders.
- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That:
- 21 (a) There is a Task Force <u>Blue Ribbon Commission</u> on Alzheimer's Disease 22 and Related Disorders.

10 11 12 13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of September 30, 2012, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
