A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Electricity Market – Goal of the State – Best Possible Price for Ratepayers**
3 **Through Reregulation**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that, on and after a certain date, the goal of the State is
5 to return as soon as possible to a regulated electricity market for certain
6 customer classes that results in a reliable electricity system at the best possible
7 price for certain ratepayers; providing that the purpose of a certain current
8 statute that establishes customer choice, competitive retail electricity markets,
9 and deregulation of generation of electricity remains in effect until a certain
10 other date; requiring the Public Service Commission to develop a certain
11 transition plan; and generally relating to the goal of the State to return to a
12 regulated electricity market for certain customers.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Public Utility Companies**

21 7–504.

22 (A) [The] **UNTIL THE END OF JUNE 30, 2010**, THE General Assembly finds
23 and declares that the purpose of this subtitle is to:

1 (1) establish customer choice of electricity supply and electricity
2 supply services;

3 (2) create competitive retail electricity supply and electricity supply
4 services markets;

5 (3) deregulate the generation, supply, and pricing of electricity;

6 (4) provide economic benefits for all customer classes; and

7 (5) ensure compliance with federal and State environmental
8 standards.

9 **(B) ON AND AFTER JULY 1, 2010, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND**
10 **DECLARES THAT IT IS THE GOAL OF THE STATE TO RETURN AS SOON AS**
11 **POSSIBLE TO A REGULATED ELECTRICITY MARKET FOR THE RESIDENTIAL AND**
12 **SMALL COMMERCIAL CUSTOMER CLASSES THAT RESULTS IN A RELIABLE**
13 **ELECTRICITY SYSTEM AT THE BEST POSSIBLE PRICE FOR THOSE RATEPAYERS.**

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Public Service
15 Commission shall develop a transition plan to meet the goal stated under § 7-504(b) of
16 the Public Utility Companies Article as enacted by this Act.

17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 July 1, 2010.
