8 9	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12	In this title, "public charter school" means a public school that:
13	(1) Is nonsectarian in all its programs, policies, and operations;
14	(2) Is a school to which parents choose to send their children;
15 16 17	(3) [Is] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 9–102.1 OF THIS TITLE, IS open to all students on a space—available basis and admits students on a lottery basis if more students apply than can be accommodated;
18	(4) Is a new public school or a conversion of an existing public school;
19	(5) Provides a program of elementary or secondary education or both;
20	(6) Operates in pursuit of a specific set of educational objectives;
21	(7) Is tuition–free;
22	(8) Is subject to federal and State laws prohibiting discrimination;
