FEDERAL MILITARY BASE IN THE STATE SHALL BE OPEN TO STUDENTS WITH

1	PARENTS ASSIGNED TO THE BASE ON A LOTTERY BASIS AND, IF REMAINING
2	SPACE IS AVAILABLE, TO ALL OTHER STUDENTS ON A LOTTERY BASIS.
3 4	(A) THE STATE BOARD MAY GRANT A WAIVER FROM § 9–102(3) OF THIS TITLE TO A PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL IF THE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL:
