SENATE BILL 857

1 (a) An organization listed in subsection (b) of this section shall obtain a 2 permit from the county commissioners before the organization may use two or more of 3 the following gaming devices in conducting a fundraiser at which prizes of 4 merchandise or money may be awarded:

- 5 (1) a paddle wheel;
- 6 (2) a wheel of fortune;
- 7 (3) a chance book;
- 8 (4) a card game;
- 9 (5) a raffle; or
- 10 (6) any other gaming device.

11 (d) (3) The county commissioners may [not issue more than two permits] 12 **DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF PERMITS TO ISSUE** to an organization in a single 13 year.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJuly 1, 2010.
