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- 3 (d) (1) "Public school employee" means a certificated professional 4 individual who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent 5 status in Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual 6 designated by the public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided 7 in § 6–408(b) of this subtitle.
- 8 (3) In Baltimore County, "public school employee" includes:
- 9 (i) A secondary school nurse, an elementary school nurse, and a 10 special school nurse; and
- 11 (ii) Supervisory noncertificated employees as defined under \S 12 6-501(h) of this title.

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- 14 (a) Each public school employer shall designate, as provided in this subtitle, 15 which employee organization, if any, shall be the exclusive representative of all public 16 school employees in a specified unit in the county.
- 17 (b) [(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the] **THE**18 public school employer shall determine the composition of the unit in negotiation with
 19 any employee organization that requests negotiation concerning the composition of the
 20 unit.
- [(2) In Baltimore County, the public school employer may designate a separate unit comprised of all registered nurses employed by the county in elementary schools or special schools.]
