A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Orthodontic Care – Reimbursement**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to adopt
4 a certain reimbursement procedure for orthodontic care provided to certain
5 Maryland Medical Assistance Program recipients; defining a certain term; and
6 generally relating to reimbursement for orthodontic care under the Maryland
7 Medical Assistance Program.

10 Section 15–114.2

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Health – General**

16 **15–114.2.**

17 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “ORTHODONTIC CARE” MEANS DENTAL SERVICES**
18 **RELATED TO THE DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF IRREGULARITIES OF THE**
19 **TEETH, MALOCCLUSIONS, AND ASSOCIATED ORAL–FACIAL ABNORMALITIES.**

20 **(B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT A PROCEDURE FOR THE**
21 **REIMBURSEMENT OF ORTHODONTISTS THAT ALLOWS FOR THE FULL AMOUNT**
22 **OF REIMBURSEMENT AUTHORIZED UNDER THE PROGRAM FOR ORTHODONTIC**
23 **CARE THAT INVOLVES INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ORTHODONTIC**
24 **BRACES FOR A PROGRAM RECIPIENT IF:**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 **(1) THE ORTHODONTIC CARE IS COVERED UNDER THE PROGRAM;**

2 **(2) THE PROGRAM RECIPIENT DOES NOT RECEIVE THE FULL**
3 **NUMBER OF VISITS AUTHORIZED UNDER THE PROGRAM BECAUSE THE**
4 **ORTHODONTIST TREATING THE PROGRAM RECIPIENT DETERMINES THAT IT IS**
5 **NOT MEDICALLY NECESSARY FOR THE PROGRAM RECIPIENT TO RECEIVE THE**
6 **FULL NUMBER OF VISITS; AND**

7 **(3) FOR A PROGRAM RECIPIENT WHO IS A DEPENDENT, THE**
8 **PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF THE PROGRAM RECIPIENT IS SATISFIED WITH THE**
9 **ORTHODONTIC CARE PROVIDED TO THE PROGRAM RECIPIENT.**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 July 1, 2010.
